## Dangerous Goods and Restricted Items in Passenger Baggage

Passenger Information

### Purpose

This document gives passengers practical information on dangerous goods and restricted items that may or may not be carried in checked baggage, cabin baggage or on the person when travelling with Air Montenegro.

### Important passenger information

- Dangerous goods must not be carried in passenger baggage except where specifically permitted under the applicable conditions.
- Some items may be accepted only with prior Air Montenegro approval. Approval is not automatic and the item may be refused if the required information is not provided or if carriage is not possible due to regulatory, safety, security or operational requirements.
- Where prior approval is required, passengers must contact Air Montenegro Contact Center at [contact.center@airmontenegro.com](mailto:contact.center@airmontenegro.com) at least 48 hours before departure and provide the item description, quantity, battery Watt-hour rating or lithium content where relevant, and any additional documentation requested by Air Montenegro.
- Certain approved items require Air Montenegro to inform the pilot-in-command of their location on board. Such items must be declared before acceptance and may be carried only after all applicable handling requirements have been completed.
- Ammunition is not accepted by Air Montenegro. Passengers must not bring ammunition in checked baggage, cabin baggage or on their person.
- Power banks are limited to a maximum of two per person, up to 100 Wh each. They must be carried in cabin baggage or on the person and must not be placed in checked baggage.
- Power banks must not be recharged from the aircraft power supply during the flight, should not be used to recharge other portable electronic devices while onboard, and should not be stored in overhead compartments.
- Dangerous goods acceptance is separate from aviation security screening. Airport security or competent authorities may refuse an article even where it is permitted under dangerous goods provisions.

## Carriage Conditions for Dangerous Goods and Restricted Items in Passenger Baggage

The table below provides passenger information on dangerous goods and items whose carriage is prohibited or restricted in passenger baggage, including items that may be carried in checked or cabin baggage only if the prescribed conditions are met and, where applicable, prior approval has been obtained from Air Montenegro. Items permitted in cabin baggage may also be carried on the person, unless otherwise specified in the table.

## Battery-specific passenger summary

This summary is included because passenger handling questions most often concern lithium batteries, power banks, portable electronic devices, smart luggage, bag tags and e-cigarettes.

All lithium batteries and battery-powered devices must use batteries of a type that meets the requirements of the UN Manual of Tests and Criteria, Part III, subsection 38.3. Where the Watt-hour rating or lithium metal content cannot be verified, carriage may be refused.

## Security prohibited articles - cabin baggage and hold baggage

Dangerous goods acceptance is separate from aviation security screening. Airport security may refuse articles even where an item is not a dangerous good. The following summary reflects the passenger prohibited-articles list supplied for cabin baggage/security restricted areas and hold baggage.

Location	Articles not permitted
<b>Security restricted areas and cabin/on board</b>	Guns, firearms and other projectile devices; stunning devices; objects with a sharp point or sharp edge; workmen's tools capable of causing serious injury or threatening aircraft safety; blunt instruments; explosives and incendiary substances and devices.
<b>Hold baggage</b>	Explosives and incendiary substances and devices, including ammunition, blasting caps, detonators/fuses, mines, grenades, pyrotechnics, smoke-generating items, dynamite, gunpowder and plastic explosives.

## Passenger notice

*This information is intended to help passengers prepare for travel. Air Montenegro may refuse any item where carriage is not permitted, where prior approval has not been obtained, where the passenger cannot provide sufficient information, or where airport security, legal or operational requirements do not allow carriage.*
